If the City of Raleigh determines that the water and/or sewer system does not meet the City's standards as outlined on page 2 of this application, the City will notify the owner of reasons for denial.

If conditions are met, the City of Raleigh will notify owner and owner may proceed with as-built plan. Once as-built has been submitted and approved by the City, the Owner may begin the easement dedication process. Upon final approval of deeds by the City, the Owner may submit signed deeds and payment to the City and the City of Raleigh will record deeds. Upon recordation of deeds the ownership will be transferred to the City of Raleigh.

UTILITY SYSTEM OWNERSHIP TRANFER APPLICATION

Privately owned water distribution mains and sewer collection mains may be dedicated to the City of Raleigh for ownership, operation and maintenance if those systems meet the following conditions:

The Water distribution systems and sewer collection systems are constructed in conformance with the City of Raleigh Public Utilities Handbook and comply with all state and federal requirements for publicly owned water and sewer systems;

The mains must be properly sized and have sufficient capacity to serve the community according to the requirements of the City of Raleigh Public Utilities Handbook and all state and federal requirements for publicly owned water and sewer systems.

The condition of the mains and accessories are in good working order and do not require repair at the time of dedication.

The system is not currently connected to the City of Raleigh Public System through a master meter.

The Owner shall provide easement area as required by the Raleigh Public Utilities Handbook for proper operation and maintenance of the mains, meters, and other accessories. For mains within existing private street right-of-ways, the easement area may be synonymous with the right-of-way lines such that all public mains and appurtenances are within the easement.

The Owner shall provide engineering record drawings of the water and sewer systems in accordance with the City of Raleigh Public Utilities Handbook.

The Owner shall provide a spreadsheet with all landowners including name, address, REID (Real Estate ID), and Type of Easement (Water/Sewer),

Upon the submittal of a completed application, the Raleigh Director of Public Utilities or the Director's designee will review the application for compliance with the standards above. If the City determines that the utility system(s) to be conveyed meet the standard above, the applicant shall dedicate the system and appropriate easements for the components of the utility system to be conveyed by deed of easement. The City will approve and record the deed or deeds in the appropriate county register of deeds at no cost to the City. The applicant will be responsible for all cost associated with the deed recordation. Any private utility system that does not meet the requirements and standards as outlined above, shall not be accepted by the City for ownership, operation, and maintenance of such system.
