They typically appear in front of small shops or restaurants but also are used as room dividers or doorway curtains. Using shibori manipulations in stitching, folding and binding, folding and clamping and other compressions, participants will create patterns or motifs that speak of summer. Indigo also plays into image making and blue is a cooling hue. Combining the two, students will create a piece that speaks to the season. All tools and fabric will be provided; however, participants may bring their own cloth choices for personal explorations.
