

PULLEN ARTS CENTER GALLERY PROGRAM

Designed to serve as one of the City of Raleigh's community exhibition spaces, Pullen Arts Center's Gallery Program has introduced hundreds of artists to area residents and visitors.

Mission

Our Gallery Program showcases a broad spectrum of visual arts, featuring works by Pullen Arts Center students and staff along with local, regional and internationally acclaimed artists. With the goal of providing a meaningful educational experience for people of all ages and backgrounds, our exhibits inspire, enlighten and enhance the cultural environment of our community.

Eligibility

- ❖ Visual artists in all mediums
- ❖ Solo and group shows are welcome to apply

Selection Process

Applications are reviewed by Pullen Arts Center's gallery director, who will determine which works will be exhibited. Once artists are selected, they will be contacted by Pullen.

Submission Requirements

- ❖ **Submission Deadline: June 1, 2015 for the January-December 2016 season.**
- ❖ Please submit images of the works you would be like to exhibit. Images may be submitted digitally or by mail. (If you would like your mailed images returned, please include a self-addressed return envelope.)
- ❖ Include full contact info and dates/months that your artwork is available for exhibit.
- ❖ Indicate if you are interested in having a reception and /or gallery talk, open to the public.
- ❖ Indicate if you approve of us sharing your artwork images and contact info with Sertoma Arts Center to be considered for a gallery exhibit with them.

Further Information

- ❖ Pullen Arts Center will determine which works will be exhibited and where they will be hung. Most artworks are placed in group shows. There are three glass-enclosed cases suitable for 3-d and 2-d hung artworks, and wall space in the reception area for painting and 2-d artwork.
- ❖ Pullen Arts Center will finalize the 2016 exhibition schedule on or before August 1, 2015.
- ❖ Five exhibitions will be scheduled for January - December 2016. Duration of each exhibition is typically two months: January-February, May-June, July-August and September-October unless otherwise specified. Two exhibitions each year feature Pullen program and class promotions and the November-December slot is reserved for the Pullen staff and participants show. Three exhibitions each year are open to non-Pullen artists.
- ❖ Works may or may not be for sale. All sales are coordinated by the Pullen Arts Center. A 25% commission plus current NC sales tax goes to Pullen Arts Center for each work sold.
- ❖ All transportation of works to be exhibited is the responsibility of the artist.
- ❖ Pullen Arts Center is primarily used for educational purposes. Works can also be shown at our annual craft show and/or salon sale.
