Get ready for a fun class of discovering techniques for fusing glass in a kiln. In this introduction to fusing glass, you will learn the fundamentals and principles of preparing glass for firing in a kiln while creating tiles, plates and bowls for decorative or functional use. No previous experience with glass is necessary. All tools will be provided: students purchase glass from Pullen Arts Center. Included will be instruction in all the basics of warm glass, glass compatibility, annealing and slumping. After their designs are fused in a kiln, students will learn to use molds for slumping, the controlled bending or sinking of glass to add shape and function to fused glass. The end results will be small plates, platters and bowls. Students purchase glass for projects at class (starting at approx. \$30 depending on the size and number of projects).
