In this two day workshop we will be drawing and painting the portrait from life. Our drawings will be a 'tool' that we will use to complete the painting. We will use short gesture and longer poses to understand our subjects. After several drawing studies, we will turn our focus to the values of the head. This is an extremely helpful step when translating color into values. Starting with easy foundation color recipes and working in our shades, middle tones and highlights, this workshop will also utilize many application techniques to establish the essence and personality of our subjects. Live models will pose as the instructor guides you with several demonstrations, resource materials and one on one critiques. ## **Pottery - Workshop: Enhancing Your Handbuilding Skills**

Age: 16yrs and up. It's time to hone your handbuilding skills! In this 2 day hands on workshop, we will discuss developing quality work and finding your voice in clay. Demonstrations include new approaches to forming unique and decisive functional pots. Using slabs, coils, and basic handbuilt elements, we will establish practices for properly using molds, design templates and stamps to expand your range of form and surface. Learn how to punctuate your work with lids that fit, feet, nice handles, and clean design. On the second day, we will concentrate on finishing your work with techniques that include different ways of using slips and stains to decorate greenware, and successfully apply glazes. Prerequisite: Beginner handbuilding at Pullen or Sertoma. Bring lunch and any basic handbuilding tools you have. Clay can be purchased at the first class. Slips provided. Jennifer Stas instructs.

## **Pottery – Mechanics of Glaze Mixing**

Age: 16yrs and up. Tens of thousands of pottery glaze recipes are available to contemporary potters in books, magazines, and on the internet. In this workshop you will learn how to take those formulas, create a usable batch size and prepare glazes for your pots. Important topics of discussion include calculating glaze materials needed, necessary equipment to formulate and prepare the glaze and safety precautions. No previous glaze mixing or formulation skills are necessary. This workshop does not qualify students for a studio card. Randy Hinson instructs. Bring a bag lunch or snack.

## **Pottery – Exploring Closed Forms**

Age: 16yrs and up. This 3 session hands on wheel course will explore closed forms and the many types of pots that can be made from this technique. Throwing closed forms takes practice. The student should be comfortable throwing and shaping cylinders, and collaring the clay to close the form. The main focus of the class will be trimming and finishing techniques used to create lidded pots (including the 'chopstick' box), flower arrangers, and decorative objects, from the closed form once the clay is leather hard. Prerequisite beginner or intermediate wheel at Sertoma or Pullen Art Center. Tina Granville instructs.

## **Pottery – Handbuilding: Beginning**

Age: 16yrs and up. This class explores techniques including pinching, coils and slabs, including an overview of ceramic materials and glazing. Classes provide demonstrations and individual work time with instructor guidance. Students are encouraged to practice between class sessions and will have free access to Sertoma's well-equipped studio. New students may not miss more than 2 classes and must attend the first class and the glazing class (approx. 5 week), in order to qualify for a studio card. Students will purchase materials at first class (approx. \$42). All skill levels welcome! Tim Cherry instructs.

## **Pottery – Handbuilding: Advanced**

Age: 16yrs and up. Through a combination of demonstrations and individual work time, students will further develop their handbuilding skills while making distinctive pieces including planters, unique boxes and tile. The variety of construction techniques used will include soft slabs, stiff slabs, and coils. Students will learn to add flair and professionalism to their pieces by adding finishing touches such as feet and handles. This class will also help individuals develop and express their own unique style through clay! Prerequisite: Beginning Handbuilding class at Sertoma or Pullen Arts or comparable experience. Students who are new to Sertoma must attend the first class which covers safety and studio orientation as well as the glazing class (approx 5th class) in order to qualify for a studio card. ## **Pottery – Wheel Throwing: Beginner**

Age: 16yrs and up. This course introduces students to the basics of 'throwing' pottery, provides them with an understanding of ceramic terms, processes, and knowledge needed to use the pottery studio safely and independently. Topics include centering clay, throwing basic forms, handles, and glazing. Sessions include demonstrations and practice time under the guidance of the instructor. Students are encouraged to practice between class sessions and have free access to Sertoma's well-equipped studio. New students may miss no more than two classes and must attend the first class and the glazing class (approx. 6th week), in order to qualify for a studio card. Purchase materials at first class (approx. \$40). This is a 7-week class. Joan Walsh instructs.
