Each semester begins anew with the learning of new pieces of music, culminating in a free public concert for friends and family. 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Pottery – Wall Clock Face Workshop

Age: 7-15yrs. Children will be able to use their imaginations to create clocks from clay. The first meeting will be working with the wet clay to make the shape and cut out embellishments. In this workshop students will learn techniques such as slab rolling, creating texture and drawing with a needle tool to make a fully functional (yet delightfully whimsical) wall clock.
