Ed McMahon is a senior resident fellow at the Urban Land Institute (ULI). He holds the Charles E. Fraser Chair for Sustainable Development and Environmental Policy, leading ULI's efforts to conduct research and educational activities related to green and sustainable development practices.

Mr. McMahon is an attorney, community planner, lecturer, author and nationally renowned authority on sustainable development, land conservation, historic preservation, and urban design. He was formerly the vice president and director of land use programs at The Conservation Fund, where he worked to improve both land conservation and land development practices, through programs that balance economic and environmental goals.

He has organized successful efforts to acquire and protect urban parkland, wilderness areas and other conservation properties, and has made numerous presentations on the topics of tourism, conservation, land use planning and historic preservation. Mr. McMahon is also the co-founder and former president of Scenic America, a national non-profit organization devoted to protecting America's scenic landscapes.

Mr. McMahon has an M.A. in Urban Studies from the University of Alabama and a J.D. from Georgetown University Law School, where he taught law and public policy from 1976 to 1985.
