Accomplishments

- ▶ Raleigh added 11.5 miles of new bike facilities
 - 4.5 miles of Bike Lanes
 - 6 miles of Sharrows
 - Total Network = 22.5 miles
- ▶ Endorsed the adoption of the Comprehensive Pedestrian Plan
- ▶ Developed new prioritization process for Capital Streetscape Program
- ▶ Conducted public outreach for:
 - Hillsborough Street Road Diet between Oberlin Road and Morgan Street
 - Oberlin Road Bicycle Project



On-Street Bike Parking Coming Soon!

- ▶ City Council approved removal of one on-street vehicular parking space to install Raleigh's first on-street bike corral
- ▶ Saris Cycling Group donated bike corral
 - Big thanks to Kristy Jackson!
- ▶ Corral to be installed on Hargett Street in front of Stitch and Raleigh Times in May!
