### Flood-Prone Properties Restored to Green Space

The City of Raleigh's Stormwater Management Division has had many successes over the last year through its participation in the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) Flood Hazard Mitigation Grant Program. The program provides funding to the City when it purchases properties, like Capital Inn on Capital Boulevard in Raleigh, that experience ongoing flooding as result of being built in the floodplain prior to current development regulations. After a property is purchased, the area is restored to green space so that the floodplain functions more naturally. This reduces flooding in the area and improves public safety. Participation in the program is voluntary. Some projects may also be funded through the City's Stormwater Utility. Attendance: 13 residents, 5 staff, District B counselor, David Cox, 1 guest

Welcome and Call to Order by Shelley Winters. Last Month's minutes approved.

Neighborhood roll call: Brentwood, Pine Knoll, Walden Woods, Pinecrest

Reports:

RALEIGH POLICE DEPT, Sgt. Schabel, Trash issue on Pine Knoll is being addressed. North District reported crimes are: 9 vandalisms, 4 commercial burglaries and 6 residential burglaries with suspect info known, 37 assaults in local hotels, bars and neighborhoods, 39 Drug stops on Capital, Millbrook and Falls of Neuse.

COUNCIL David Cox, david.cox@raleighnc.gov Brentwood Streetscape projects should be known by end of year. HR policy being studied by Dept. heads and other administrative offices. Municipal Bonds for Transportation Improvement: Jason Myers, COR Transportation Planner Dept of Transportation. Plans for all of Ral., around \$1B. Needs are being prioritized for safety, cost, congestion, bike lanes, etc. Bond Proposal on ballot for \$206.7 M for transportation projects completion. Some of local interest are: 1. Atlantic Ave widening on commercial side (not residential side) with sidewalks from NHC to Highwood Blvd. 2. Capital Blvd , Trawick/MarshCreek, widen to 3 lanes, sidewalks and curb and gutter with discussion about assessments, 3. Old Wake Forest Rd, 4 lanes from Atlantic Ave to Spring Forest (behind Waffle House near Millbrook HS), 4. Six Forks from Rowan to Lynn Rd widening, 5. Blount/ Person St area. Planning about sidewalks and Safe Rts to schools.

Brian Dempster, guest spoke about the need to vote Yes on the Transportation Bond citing Development concerns about safety, solving traffic problems and funding of city wide projects.
