Flood-Prone Properties Restored to Green Space

The City of Raleigh's Stormwater Management Division has had many successes over the last year through its participation in the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) Flood Hazard Mitigation Grant Program.

The program provides funding to the City when it purchases properties, like Capital Inn on Capital Boulevard in Raleigh, that experience ongoing flooding as result of being built in the floodplain prior to current development regulations. After a property is purchased, the area is restored to green space so that the floodplain functions more naturally. This reduces flooding in the area and improves public safety. Participation in the program is voluntary. Some projects may also be funded through the City's Stormwater Utility.
