1. Mr. Charles Rodman called the South Citizens Advisory Council's meeting to order on November 13, 2017 at 7pm.
2. The minutes from October 9, 2017 were read and approved.
3. Sr. Officer Leggett of the Raleigh Police Department and the South CAC reported the statistics for the past 28 days:
 - a. Officer Leggett reported over the last 28 days assaults were down there were two assaults in Fox Ridge Manor Apartment Complex.
 - b. Residential burglaries were up and becoming more problematic, thieves continue to target sheds and motor vehicles. Please remember to lock and secure your tool sheds to help prevent theft from occurring.
 - c. Remember this is the Holiday Season, do not leave your vehicles idling. Remember as you are out and about **lock, take, and hide your valuables from plain view in your vehicles.**
4. Eric Leath from Colliers International was present for questions and to provide answers regarding the zoning case for the residential building propose for the corner of Rock Quarry & Sunny Brook Road. The proposed 14 units per acre will be affordable housing limited to residential use only.
5. A motion was made and moved to, table the discussions on the Residential zoning, until additional information is provided to the South CAC Citizens to approve the zoning case.
6. Daniel Coleman from the South Central CAC was present at the South CAC meeting on November 13, 2017 he collected names from South CAC members for naming the Walnut Creek Wetland Center in honor of Dr. Norman Camp.
7. Mr. Gerry Massey, Resources for Seniors: not present

Ms. Sharon Taybron, Coordinator for Capital Area Youth Build Program for youths that are in need of obtaining their GED and acquiring jobs skills and educational opportunities to help them to become productive individuals and citizens. Basic eligibility requirements you must live in the following zip code areas 27601, 27604 and 27610 and between 16- 24 years old, and a currently/previous dropout. Councilman Corey Branch was present at the South CAC November's meeting he explained the new proposed shopping center across from Food Lion in South Gate Shopping Center is zoned for commercial retail. Councilman Branch also gave updates on the transportation bond regarding widening of Rock Quarry Road, in Southeast to Sunnybrook Road, and I-40 to Clayton. The proposed road widening project is scheduled for 2018.
