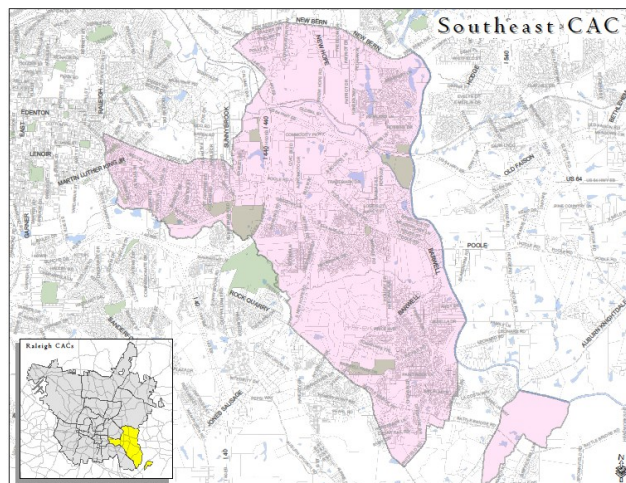

Southeast CAC Meeting Minutes

Thursday November 9th 2017 at Barwell Road Community Center

The monthly meeting of the Southeast CAC was held at the Barwell Road Community Center on Thursday, November 9 with Co-Chair Ulysses Lane presiding. Also present were Co-Chair Lee Weaver (Worthdale), 1st Vice Chair Latonia Williams, Secretary, Julia Matthews-McClain (Barwell Road) and Community Specialist Jonathan Edwards.

Raleigh Parks, Recreation & Cultural Resources Report was given by Barwell Road Community Center Assistant Director, Kevin Sanders. Raleigh Police Report was presented by Officer Antoinette Council. We learned the Southeast Policing Unit personnel will be changing. Officer Antoinette Council and Officer Roderick Lee will have different assignments. Officer Mulvett will take Officer Council's place at the Southeast CAC meetings. Co-Chair Ulysses Lane expressed his thanks to both officers for their work with the Southeast CAC. A power point presentation will be presented at a future Southeast CAC meeting about the Southeast District Policing Unit.

Code Enforcement Report was presented by Jason Jones. Mr. Jones provided information for us to check the smoke and carbon detectors. He answered questions from the community about public nuisances and vehicles on the property. The Code Enforcement division strives to improve and maintain the quality of life and environment for all City of Raleigh's residents.

City of Raleigh Planning, Planner I, Hannah Reckhow provided a power point presentation on the rezoning process. The rezoning process has multiple steps to follow and the slide presentation indicated how the CAC provides a vital impact on the process. Ms. Reckhow mentioned the 2030 Comprehensive Plan Update online survey is available. To access the online survey visit raleighnc.gov/cp and click on the link titled 2030 Comprehensive Plan Update. The survey will be open until December 3, 2017.

YouthBuild Coordinator for Capital Area Workforce Development, Sharon Taybron spoke.
