



## THREAT OF HEAVY RAIN AND SEVERE STORMS TODAY

Periods of moderate to heavy rain are likely today through tonight. Rainfall amounts will total 1-2 inches with locally higher totals. Flash flood watches are in effect from the NC mountains eastward into the western Piedmont, including the Triad.

A few strong to severe storms are possible today in Central NC. The main threat will be 9 am to 7 pm west and 2 pm to midnight east. These storms could produce damaging wind gusts over 60 mph, and isolated tornadoes are possible as well. Please make sure you have a way to receive National Weather Service watches and warnings today.
