Project Description:

The City of Raleigh Department of City Planning invites firms to submit qualifications for consulting services to undertake a study focusing on land use, transportation, redevelopment, and urban design recommendations for improvements to the character and functional design of the Avent Ferry Road Corridor. A qualified multi-disciplinary team of engineering, design, planning, and economic experts will be selected based on the proven excellence in preparing studies that encompass the following elements:

- Analysis of existing transportation conditions and capacity
- Traffic engineering and modeling
- Multi-modal transportation infrastructure planning and design
- Land use planning
- Urban design and placemaking strategies
- Market analysis and development economics
- Substantive community and stakeholder outreach and engagement
- Order-of-magnitude cost estimating and implementation strategies

The City proposes a unique working relationship between staff and the consultants. City staff will take responsibility for executing the bulk of the public outreach strategy, including all meeting logistics and social media promotion, as well as authoring and producing the final report. The consultant team will produce technical documents, analysis, and plan graphics; and assist with meeting and civic engagement design and facilitation. Consultant services will be required from the date of a fully executed contract through the subsequent 16 month period, or the date of successful completion of performing the tasks and work products defined in this RFQ.
