During the community engagement session on August 10th, numerous attendees stated that employment opportunities and job training were areas of need for the residents of Washington Terrace and the College Park/Idlewild neighborhoods.

As part of the continuing Neighborhood Revitalization Strategy Area (NSRA) efforts, we are partnering with various agencies to provide information and assistance to address some of the expressed resident concerns.

On Thursday, October 15, we will host a presentation by Capital Area Workforce Development. Capital Area Workforce Development is a public-private partnership that focuses on economic development by ensuring the local workforce has the skills, training and education to meet the needs of local employers. As well, the board oversees NCWorks Career Centers throughout Wake County to help citizens, regardless of their circumstances or background, be more competitive candidates as they look for employment.

The **October 15** session will take place at the **Tarboro Road Community Center** from **6:30 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.** The event is open to the public and all interested residents are encouraged to attend.
