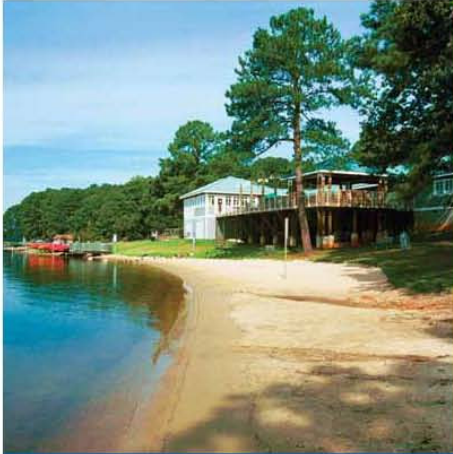

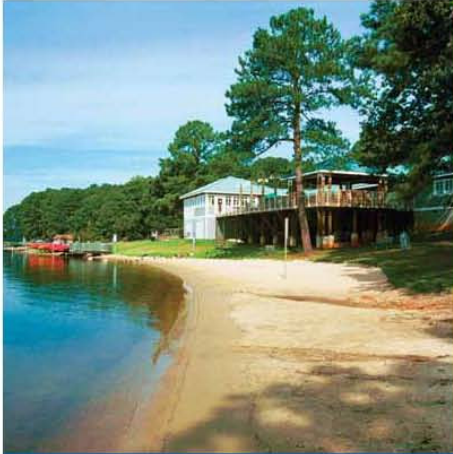

Roles of the Parent

Department Philosophy

- Positive sports parenting, Code of Conduct, and Suspension Policy (www.raleighnc.gov Keyword, Any of the community centers and look for the District B Athletic Information section.)
- Help make the game fun for kids
- Practice positive sportsmanship – cheer for both teams, don't boo or yell negative comments, be silent during free throws
- Don't boo or make derogatory comments to coaches or officials. Show support for the coaches, officials and administrators – they are here for your child.

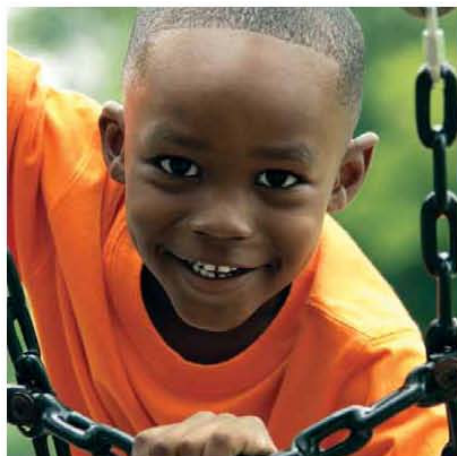


Roles of the Parent

Department Philosophy

(Continued)

- Address any concerns with coaches or community center staff at the appropriate time.
- Set a positive example for players.
- Be a “team” parent- help bring drinks and snacks, establish a “phone tree”
- Be certain to get your player(s) to every practice! They are playing to learn and they will not be able to learn during their minimum playing time in a game.

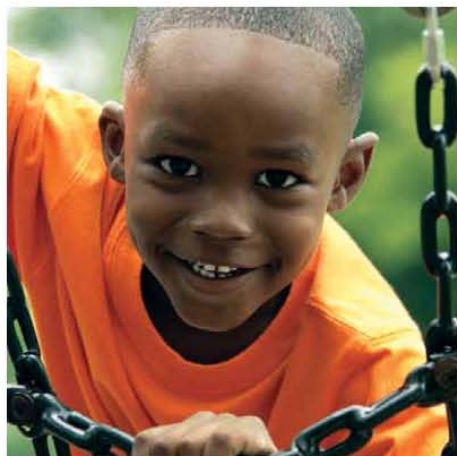


Youth Sports

Department Philosophy



- Every child is given the opportunity to participate in a safe and fun environment in the sport of his or her choice.
- It is our charge to provide as many diversified athletic offerings as possible throughout the year.
- It is encouraged that all participants are given the maximum opportunity to succeed in competition without regard to level of experience or ability.



Youth Sports

Department Philosophy

(continued)

- All coaches, participants, and spectators are expected to display good sportsmanship at all times.
- The well being of the participant must always come first. No exceptions!



Code of Conduct

The Raleigh Parks and Recreation Department expects good sportsmanship from its coaches, participants and spectators, outline below in the code of conduct.

1. No individual shall refuse to abide by any Leagues Official's decision.
2. No individual shall be guilty of objectionable demonstrations of dissent at any League Official, participant, or spectator decision.
3. No Individual other than the Coach/Captain shall discuss with any League Official in any manner the decisions reached by any League Officials.
4. No individual shall be guilty of using unnecessary rough tactics in the play of the game.
5. No individual shall at any time lay a hand on, push, shove, strike, or threaten to strike ANY League Official, participant, or spectator.
6. No individual shall be guilty of personal verbal abuse upon any League Official, participant, or spectator for any real or imaginary wrong decision or judgment.



Penalties



For rules 1 through 6, individuals ejected from the game by any league official for any of the above unsportsmanlike acts shall immediately leave the property and will be suspended until after the team's next game. Individuals that have been suspended will not be permitted to attend any athletic activities, including practices and games for that team during the suspension period. Individuals without transportation shall remain at the facility until a parent or guardian can arrive to pick them up. If the individual continues to be disruptive while at the facility, he or she will suffer further disciplinary action.



Penalties

- If a coach is removed from a game, the assistant coach will take over the head coaching responsibilities. If there is not an assistant coach available, a parent will temporarily become the coach for that team. The Athletic director should be made aware of any of these situations.
- Penalty: for violations 4 through 6, individuals will be suspended for the remainder of the season. All suspension rules still apply.

- **Uniforms/proper attire for practices & games**
- **Rules on missed practices**
- **Any rules specific to league (i.e. weight, length of bat etc.)**

Safety

Children should be escorted into the dug out and picked up at the end of game time. NO CHILD SHOULD BE LEFT AT THE FIELD AFTER A GAME WAITING FOR THEIR RIDE!

Transportation concerns- ask parents if anyone needs help with carpooling

First aid- scorekeeper/field supervisor will have first aid supplies if needed; parents may also want to put together a first aid kit; STAFF will complete accident reports upon an injury and may need some information from the parent/guardian

Please make sure that all contact information and emergency contact is still valid.

- **Players should bring a water bottle to practices and games.**
