**RESOLUTION NO. 2014 – 914**

**A RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO MAKE SIDEWALK  
IMPROVEMENTS AS DESCRIBED AND TO SET A PUBLIC HEARING**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council under the provisions of Section 6.44 of the Charter of Raleigh, Chapter 1184 of the Session Laws of North Carolina, 1949, as amended, is authorized to require sidewalk improvements without petition under the conditions therein set out; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF RALEIGH:**

**Section 1.** That it is intended that the following sidewalk improvements be made:

**Installation of approximately 235 linear feet of sidewalk on the south side of  
Frank Street from Norris Street to Brookside Drive.**

**Section 2.** That the said improvements shall be done by contract after due notice and advertisement for competitive bids in accordance with provisions of Section 6.11 of the Charter of the City of Raleigh and other pertinent provisions of the Charter and of the General Statutes of North Carolina.

**Section 3.** That a **public hearing** on all matters covered by this resolution shall be held on the **17th day of June, 2014 at 2:00 p.m.** or as soon thereafter as the matter can be reached on the agenda, in the Council Chamber, Room 201, Municipal Building, 222 West Hargett Street, Raleigh, North Carolina.
