## Project Details

- **Location:** The proposed improvements of Greyson Street will begin at Dacian Road and extend to Rose Lane. See Figure 1 for an overview of the project limits.
- **Need/Benefit:** The project objective is to improve the overall condition along with pedestrian mobility and safety along this minor residential street. Construction of concrete curb & gutter, asphalt travel lanes, and sidewalks would enhance patron safety and improve the overall condition of the road for motorists and pedestrians.
- **Description of Roadway:** Existing Greyson Street is primarily a two-lane, unpaved roadway with inadequate pedestrian accommodations. The proposed project would pave Greyson Street to provide adequate travel lanes as needed as well as adding sidewalk for pedestrian accommodations.
- **Traffic Maintenance:** Due to the low traffic volumes, limited number of private driveways, and the predominantly residential uses along Greyson Street, maintenance of traffic during construction will be addressed by closing Greyson Street to through traffic during construction. Access to individual properties will be maintained during the life of the project. The closing of Greyson Street should allow for a more efficient construction schedule.
- **Funding:** This project is funded through the City's annual Street Improvements & Paving Petitions account of the City of Raleigh Transportation Capital Improvement Program (CIP). Funding of this project is dependent on several factors, including the number and total costs of current projects, priorities of all annual street improvement and paving petition projects. Revenue to this account is also subject to change and is updated on an annual basis as approved by City Council.
