Dear Laurel Hills Dam Resident,

The City of Raleigh would like to give you an update on the Laurel Hills Dam project. The City has implemented new policies with regard to roadway improvements. As a result of the new policy changes, the original plans for Laurel Hills Dam had to be modified to incorporate these changes. In addition to the original modifications to the dam and spillway, the dam and the road on top of the dam will be a little wider to accommodate any type of future plans to widen Laurel Hills Road. The widened dam section will include a slightly wider asphalt road, curb and gutter, and sidewalk across the top of the reconstructed dam. The City will have to re-submit our permits for the project to reflect these changes but anticipate beginning construction by late summer 2015.

Some of you receiving this letter may have already been invited to an upcoming meeting on **December 11, 2014**, for the Laurel Hills Stormwater Management Study (only residents who live within the study area were notified of this meeting). I would like to give you an opportunity to view the revised Laurel Hills Dam construction plans. I will make the revised Laurel Hills Dam construction plans available prior to the already scheduled Laurel Hills Stormwater Management Study meeting from **6:00 pm to 7:00 pm at the Glen Eden Pilot Park at 1500 Glen Eden Drive, Raleigh, NC 27612**. If you cannot attend this meeting, the revised plans will be available on the City's web site at <http://www.raleighnc.gov/> and search for "Laurel Hills Dam".
