

## Speed Limit Reduction Petition Process

Residents who want the speed limit reduced on their street must now show their support for the reduction by going through the petition process. The petition process requires signatures from one resident or property owner of each property on the petitioned street in order to achieve a 75% approval. Only one signature per household will be counted. Owner's names followed by an asterisk are absentee owners and renter's signatures will be allowed for those properties. The petitions must be returned to the address below within 60 days of receipt to be eligible to continue with the process.

After receiving the completed petition, staff will validate the signatures and verify that the 75% approval has been met. Then staff will create a consent agenda item for City Council approval. Once City Council has approved the speed limit reduction then a work order will be generated to install the new speed limit signs along the street.
