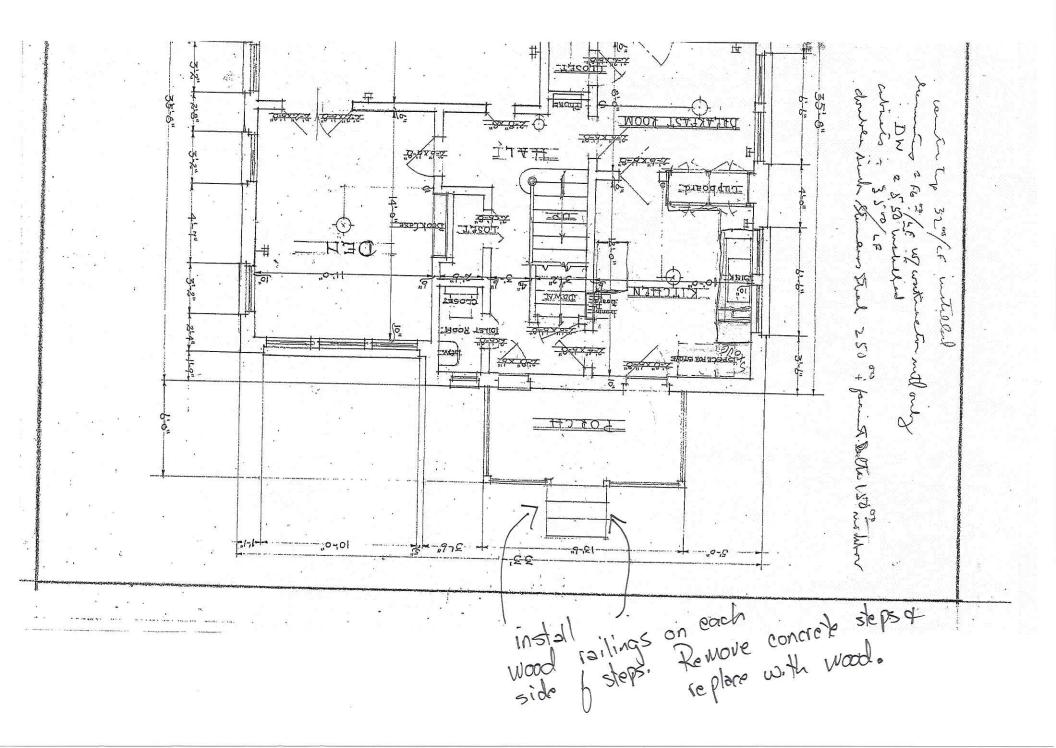

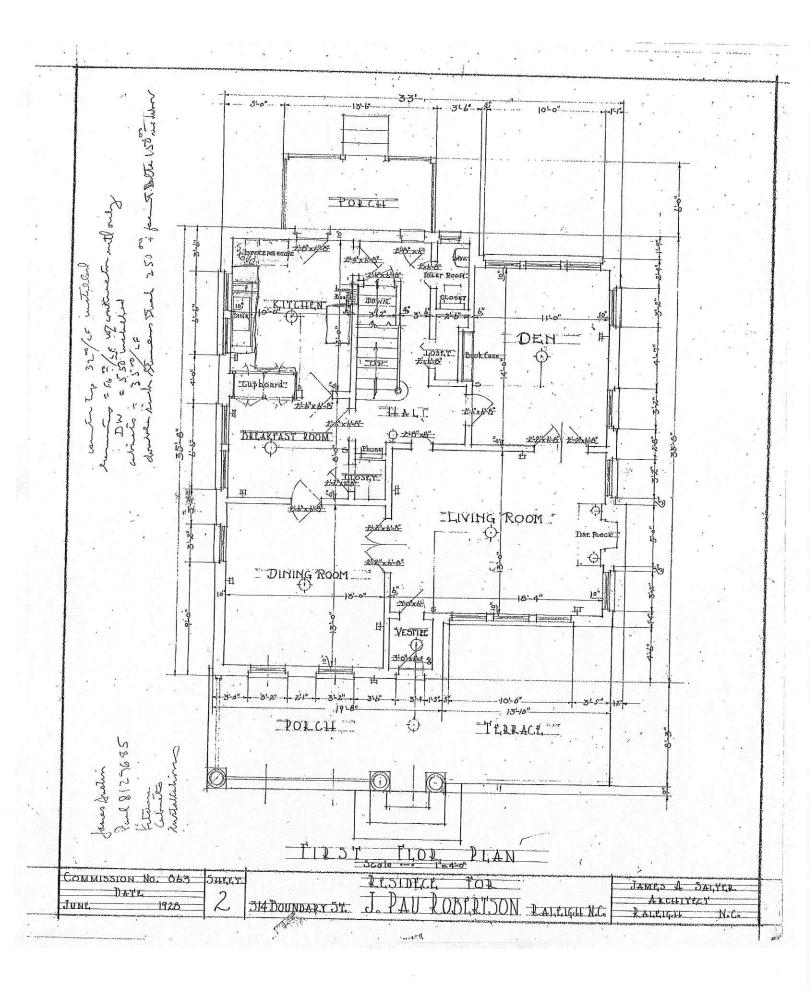

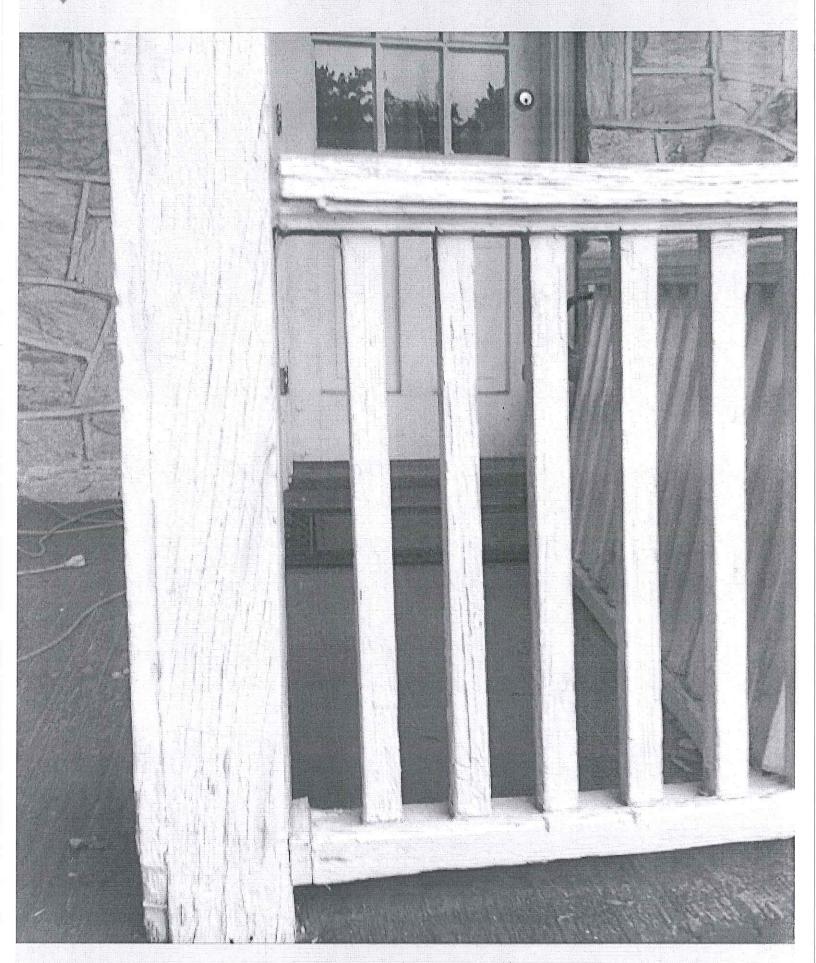
\*DETAIL A - LANDING & STAIRS

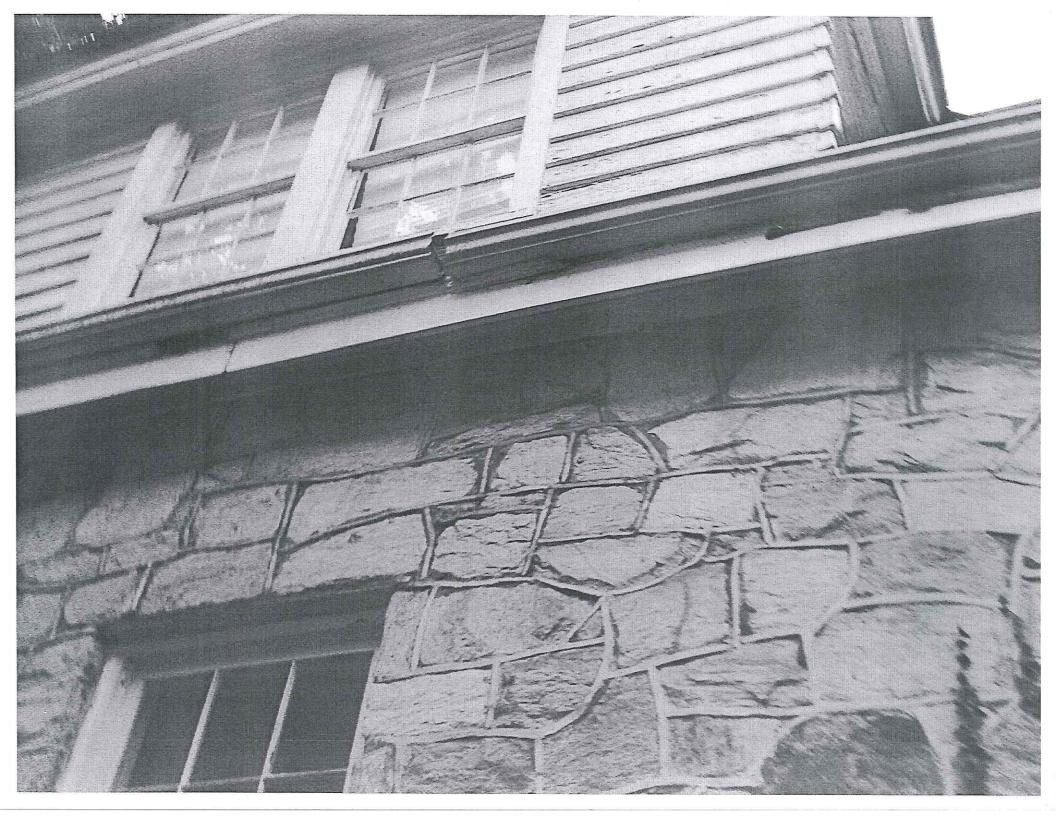

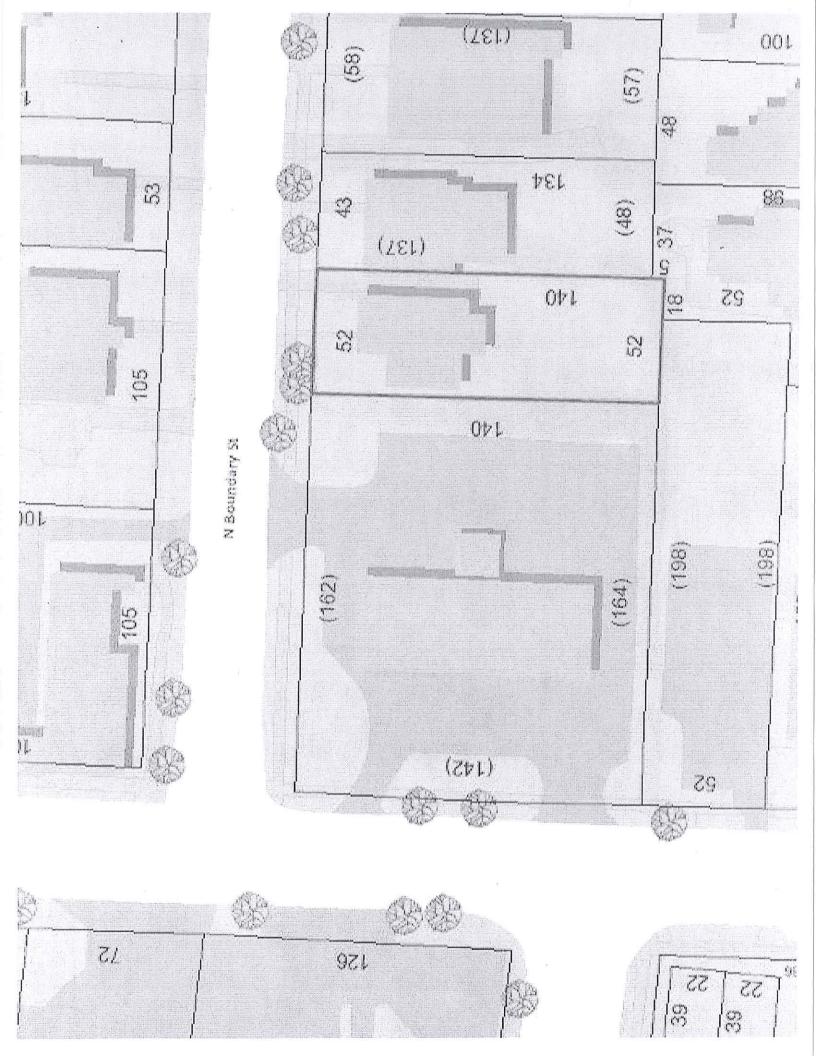
