COA Application Narrative

Description of Work

The project consists of the replacement of a light fixture on the porch with a ceiling fan. The fan will help control heat and mosquitos during the warmer months, thereby leading to increased porch use, consistent with the traditional pre-air conditioning use of porches in Oakwood.

Some internal wiring repairs will accompany the installation of the fan.
