

#### Back porch 200 Edenton st/


#### Back porch:

We propose to replace current siding with pickets and rails as it was originally. The simple plan follows all suggested designs by historic commission.


The proposed porch will be made with 2x4 rails and 2x2 pickets with a 1x3 trim piece at bottom of top rail which will have rounded edges as suggested. This design is basically a recreation of the original front porches, which are still present and in tact.

Plans included show that this is not new, and should not be changing the appearance as this back porch was originally a porch with lattice that over the years had exterior siding added with windows. This will all be demoed and replaced with the pickets and rails as to look like the rest of the porches on back of property.


