

| Tree assessment | Mulberry right side of the backyard, approximately 18" diameter. An assessment of this tree was conducted on 3-30-2018. Findings- The Tree has a significant amount of deadwood throughout the canopy. It is unclear as to why. Pruning options were being considered to remove the deadwood. Unfortunately this would leave less than 40% of the trees canopy that still produces foliage. As well, the tree would be greatly disfigured. Recommendation is for the removal of the tree as it would leave little value to the property in this condition. 
