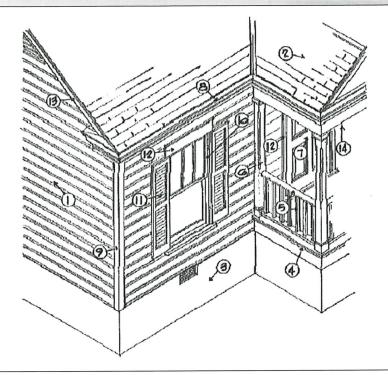

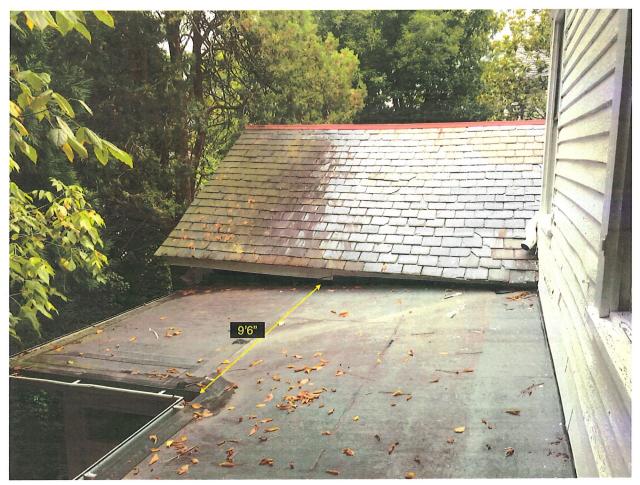

For new HVAC system, rear yard of the property is bricked into a patio and too narrow for ground-mounted exterior units. Initially we looked into side yard placement, but realized the exterior compressor could be installed on the rear flat roof above the mud room.



Coolant lines will be placed in white downspout material and only run on rear wall of the home.
