2.7.2	Windows and Doors	Existing front door does not appear to be original. It
2.7.7	Windows and Doors	does not have glass and is only 1 1/4" thick, which is thinner than most exterior and interior doors. The thickness is a safety concern and the door does not allow light into front foyer/hallway. Almost all front doors in Oakwood have glass in the upper half, as was very common for the period. Remove existing front door, which does not seem to be original or appropriate for the neighborhood and replace it with a repurposed, historic, heart pine, 1 3/4" door with half glass as shown in proposal photos. Door will be stained natural for aged heart pine.
