Don't Trash Raleigh - It's Illegal

Violating the Litter Law is a misdemeanor that carries a fine of \$100 to \$500 an/or a maximum of 24 hours of public service for the first offense. conviction on a second or subsequent offense can bring a fine of up to \$1,000 and/or up to 50 hours of public service.
