NCSU's Encore Offers Lifetime of Learning

The encore Center for Lifelong Enrichment provides an enjoyable way to stay mentally fit and active. Located at North Carolina State University's McKimmon Center, Encore offers a variety of no-credit courses, study trips and special events for adults over the age of 50. Because the classes are non-credit, there are no tests or grades and any reading or homework is optional. Encore is all about learning for the love of learning!

Encore presents 80 short courses annually on a variety of subjects ranging from the arts and literature to financial planning and gardening. Courses are taught by university faculty and experts from the community. Participants also may travel locally or internationally through the program's study trips. Most trips feature on-site learning about the history, architecture, science and/or literature of a location. More than 1,000 adults participate in Encore each year. The center also provides opportunities for socializing and volunteering through short-term projects it organizes to benefit our community.

Attention Voters: 2008 General Election Schedule

- **September 15**, First date to request an absentee ballot to be mailed.
- **October 10**, Last day to register, change party affiliation or address. The voter



registration form must be postmarked by/or hand delivered by this date.

- **October 16**, One-stop voting begins
- **October 28**, Last day (at 5:00 p.m.) to receive absentee requests by mail and applications (for sickness or disability, November 3, 5:00 p.m.)
- **November 1**, One-stop voting ends
- **November 3**, All voted absentee ballots must be in the Board of Elections office by 5:00 p.m.
- **November 4**, General election day with polls open from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.
