CONSTRUCTION UNDER WAY ON HILLSBOROUGH STREET ROUNDBABOUTS PROJECT

During the week of June 8 through 12, construction crews will be conducting the following activities *during the day*:

- Installing duct bank for underground utilities on the south side of Hillsborough Street between Gardner and Pogue streets;
- Installing sewer lines between the south side of Hillsborough Street and the Court of the Carolinas near Tompkins Hall;
- Installing water lines, sewer lines, and the utility duct bank on the south side of Hillsborough Street from Tompkins Hall to Logan Street; and
- Installing storm drains along Pullen Road and the future Pullen Road extension, from the south side of Hillsborough Street north to Oberlin Road.

Construction crews will be conducting *nighttime construction* near the Hillsborough Street intersections at Pullen Road, including:

- Installing manholes and sewer lines near the Wardlaw Building and along Ferndell Lane.

POGUE STREET AREA TO EXPERIENCE TEMPORARY POWER OUTAGE JUNE 6 DUE TO HILLSBOROUGH STREET CONSTRUCTION

Residents and businesses along a small area of Pogue Street will be temporarily without power on Saturday June 6 from 7 a.m. to 11 a.m. The scheduled outage is due to construction work on the Hillsborough Street Project.

The utility work was originally scheduled to be done on May 30. However, Progress Energy was not able to do the work as planned. Utility crews need to accommodate the removal of an overhead electrical feeder on Hillsborough Street in front of North Carolina State University. Crews hope to complete the work in less than the scheduled four hours. Progress Energy has

completed some of the necessary work in the area and hope that will shorten the outage duration on Saturday.
