ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS
CAROLINA PINES DAM REHABILITATION # SM 2008-0029

Pursuant to the General Statutes of North Carolina, Section 143-129 et seq., sealed proposals are invited and will be received by the City of Raleigh in the office of the Stormwater Management Division until 10:00 AM EDT, 06 August 2009, at which time at a meeting in Room 305, 222 West Hargett Street, Raleigh, North Carolina, the sealed proposals will be publicly opened for construction consisting of performing the following:

Description of Work

Work of the Project includes providing, installing, and removing as required, all work necessary for the Carolina Pines Dam Rehabilitation, including, but not limited to:

1. Maintaining safe access for residents;
2. Public and private utility relocation and protection;
3. Design, provide, install and remove shoring;
4. Design, provide, install, and remove lake dewatering;
5. Trench dewatering, stormwater control, and erosion control
6. All excavation, backfill, fill, rock removal, and undercut removal;
7. Provide and install new spillway structures;
8. Provide and install new storm drainage structures;
9. Remove and dispose of existing spillway and storm drainage structures;
10. Remove existing pavement and guardrail;
11. Install new pavement, guardrail, and sidewalk;
12. Traffic control and detour signage;
13. And all other related work as outlined in the plans and specifications.

Work shall include any associated work as indicated on the plans, in the specifications, or as directed by the Project Engineer.

Base Bid: The base bid includes all work necessary for the dam rehabilitation in the Carolina Pines Avenue area as indicated in this contract.

Copies of the plans and specifications may be obtained from the City of Raleigh on Monday, 06 July 2009. A deposit fee will not be required.

A pre bid conference for all contractors, sub contractors, minority and women owned businesses will be held on Tuesday, 21 July 2009 at 2:00 PM EST in Room 305, 222 West Hargett Street, Raleigh, North Carolina.

From 06 July 2009 until the date of opening the proposals, plans and specifications of the proposed work are and will continue to be on file in the office of the Room 301, Stormwater Management Division, 222 West Hargett Street, Raleigh, North Carolina, during usual office hours, and are available to prospective bidders. No proposal will be considered or accepted unless at the time of its filing, the same shall be accompanied by a cash deposit, cashier's check, or certified check on a bank or trust company insured by the Federal Insurance Deposit Corporation (FDIC) and authorized to do business in North Carolina in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the proposal. In the alternative, a five percent (5%) bid bond issued by a corporate surety licensed by the State of North Carolina may be filed with the proposal. Bidders must be properly licensed under Chapter 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes and must comply with nondiscrimination provisions. The City is an equal opportunity Municipality and invites small, minority and/or women business contractors to bid. The City Council reserves the right to reject any or all proposals.
