DEBOY STREET PIPE REPLACEMENT # SM 2009-0041

Pursuant to the General Statutes of North Carolina, Section 143-129 *et seq.*, sealed proposals are invited and will be received by the City of Raleigh in the office of the Stormwater Management Division until 1:00 PM EDT, Tuesday, October 6, 2009, at which time at a meeting in Room 303, 222 West Hargett Street, Raleigh, North Carolina, the sealed proposals will be publicly opened for construction consisting of performing the following:

Description of Work:

The CONTRACTOR, at his own proper cost and expense and with skill and diligence, shall furnish all labor, tools, materials and equipment and do all things necessary for the proper construction and completion ready for use of the following improvements:

Work of the Project includes providing, installing, and removing as required, all work necessary for the Deboy Street Pipe Replacement, including, but not limited to:

1. Maintaining safe access for residents;
2. Public and private utility relocation, support, and protection;
3. Dewatering, stormwater control, and erosion control
4. All excavation, shoring, backfill, fill, rock removal, and undercut removal;
5. Provide and install new Class III reinforced concrete culverts and pressed concrete headwalls;
6. Remove and dispose of existing CMP and RCP culvert;
7. Remove existing pavement;
8. Install new pavement;
9. Traffic control and detour signage;
10. And all other related work as outlined in the plans and specifications.

Work shall include any associated work as indicated on the plans, in the specifications, or as directed by the Project Engineer.

Copies of the plans and specifications may be obtained from the City of Raleigh on Monday, September 14, 2009, for a refundable fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00), provided conditions are met as outlined in the bid documents.

From Monday, September 14, 2009 until the date of opening the proposals, plans and specifications of the proposed work are on file in Room 301, Stormwater Management Division, 222 West Hargett Street, Raleigh, North Carolina, during usual office hours. No proposal will be considered or accepted unless at the time of its filing, the same shall be accompanied by a cash deposit, cashier's check, or certified check on a bank or trust company insured by the Federal Insurance Deposit Corporation (FDIC) and authorized to do business in North Carolina in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the proposal. In the alternative, a five percent (5%) bid bond issued by a corporate surety licensed by the State of North Carolina may be filed with the proposal. Bidders must be properly licensed under Chapter 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes and must comply with nondiscrimination provisions. The City is an equal opportunity Municipality and invites small, minority and/or women business contractors to bid. The City Council reserves the right to reject any or all proposals.
