**ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

**HARRINGTON STREET STORM DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENTS (SM 2009-0036)**

Pursuant to the General Statutes of the State of North Carolina, Section 143-129 et seq., sealed proposals are invited and will be received by the City of Raleigh in the office of the Stormwater Management Division, Room 301 of the Raleigh Municipal Building (RMB), located at 222 W. Hargett St, Raleigh, NC 27601, until 2:00 PM EST, Wednesday, October 7, 2009 at which time at a meeting in Room 305 of the RMB sealed proposals will be publicly opened for construction consisting of providing, installing, and removing as required, all work necessary for the Harrington Street Storm Drainage Improvements including but not limited to maintaining safety and access for the public; public and private utility relocation, support, and protection; erosion and sediment control; excavation, shoring, backfill, rock removal, and undercut removal as required; installing reinforced concrete culverts and concrete structures; removing existing drainage structures, sidewalk, curb, and pavement; installing new pavement; traffic control; construction surveying; and other related work as outlined in the plans and specifications, or as directed by the Project Engineer. The base bid includes all work necessary for the project. There is a mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting on Wednesday, September 23, 2009 at 10 AM EST in Room 305 of the RMB. Copies of the plans and specifications may be obtained from Room 301 of the RMB on Wednesday, September 9, 2009, for a refundable fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00). From Wednesday, September 9, 2009 until the date of opening the proposals, plans and specifications of the proposed project will be on file in Room 301 during normal business hours and are available to prospective bidders. No proposal will be considered or accepted unless at the time of its filing the same shall be accompanied by a cash deposit, cashier's check, or certified check on a bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) and authorized to do business in NC in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the proposal. Alternatively, a five percent (5%) bid bond issued by a corporate surety licensed by the State of NC may be filed with the proposal. Bidders must be properly licensed under Chapter 87 of the NC General Statutes and must comply with nondiscrimination provisions. The City of Raleigh is an equal opportunity Municipality and invites small, minority and/or women business contractors to bid. The City Council reserves the right to reject any or all proposals.
