

## INVITATION TO BIDDERS

The City of Raleigh will open sealed bids at **2:00 p.m.** local time Tuesday, December 15, 2009 in the Public Utilities Department, Sixth Floor Conference Room, One Exchange Plaza, Suite 620, 219 Fayetteville Street Mall, Raleigh, North Carolina for one construction contract consisting of three projects:

- Southeast Beaverdam Creek Interceptor Rehabilitation/Replacement - cured-in-place lining of 1,700 linear feet of sanitary sewer ranging in size from 8-inches to 20-inches, replace approximately 3,500 linear feet of 15-inch gravity sewer, replacement of 1,200 linear feet of 8-inch sewers, and all related appurtenances.
- Hathaway Road Water Main Replacement – replace 2,200 linear feet of existing 2-inch and 6-inch water main with new 6-inch ductile iron pipe.
- Upper Pigeon House Service Area Cured-in-place Pipe Lining – lining of approximately 2,800 linear feet of existing sanitary sewer ranging in size from 8-inches to 18-inches.

Each bidder must show evidence that it is licensed under Chapter 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes. The City of Raleigh reserves the right to reject any or all bid proposals. The City Council has adopted an ordinance to establish a goal of 15% minority and women owned business participation for construction projects over \$100,000.
