

## **INVITATION TO BIDDERS**

### **City of Raleigh, North Carolina Public Utilities Department Swift Creek Water Quality Sanitary Sewer Improvements**

The City of Raleigh will open sealed bids at 2:00 pm local time on October 15, 2009, in One Exchange Plaza, Suite 620, Raleigh, North Carolina, for the construction of approximately 4,900 LF of 4" D.I. force main with special interior coating (with alternate bids for 6" D.I.), 105 LF of 8" D.I. sanitary sewer, vacuum prime wastewater duplex pump station (2 -10hp pumps), 50 kW standby diesel generator, 20' x 16' (ID) CMU Building with odor control equipment, 4" wastewater meter vault, and approximately 730 LF of 12" D.I. water main and 80 LF of 14" steel encasement bore and jack with 6" D.I. carrier pipe and 6" water master meter vault.

There will be a pre-bid conference held at 10:00 am local time on September 29, 2009, in One Exchange Plaza, Suite, 620, Raleigh, North Carolina.

Each Bid must be enclosed in a sealed envelope and addressed to the Public Utilities Director of the City of Raleigh. The name and address and the North Carolina Contractor's License Number of the Bidder must be plainly written on the outside of the envelope, and the envelope must also be marked "Bid for Swift Creek Water Quality Sanitary Sewer Improvements."

Each bidder must show evidence that it is licensed under Chapter 87 of the North Carolina General Statutes.

The City of Raleigh reserves the right to reject any or all bid proposals.

The City of Raleigh prohibits discrimination in any manner on the basis of race, color, creed, national origin, sex, age, disability, or sexual orientation and will pursue an affirmative policy of fostering, promoting and conducting business with women and minority owned business enterprises.
