CITY OF RALEIGH PROJECT SM 2009-0006
YORKGATE DRIVE STORM DRAINAGE
SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Pursuant to the General Statutes of the State of North Carolina, Section 143-129 et seq., sealed proposals are invited and will be received by the City of Raleigh in the office of the Stormwater Management Division, Room 301 of the Raleigh Municipal Building (RMB), located at 222 W. Hargett St, Raleigh, NC 27601, until 10:00 AM EST, Thursday, December 17, 2009 at which time at a meeting in Room 305 of the RMB sealed proposals will be publicly opened for construction consisting of the following:

The project generally includes construction to remove existing storm sewer system and replace with approximately 860 linear feet of 4-ft by 8-ft reinforced concrete box culvert to provide storm drainage improvements along Yorkgate Drive. In addition, the project includes outlet and stream stabilization for culverts below Leadmine Road and replacement of all associated driveway culverts and drainage features along the project corridor. The work will generally consist of clearing, grading, storm sewer pipe removal, concrete box culvert installation, outlet stabilization, utility relocations and adjustments, curb and gutter, paving, traffic control, erosion and sediment control and other related items as shown on the plans, in the contract specifications, and/or as directed by the Project Engineer. The Contractor shall also be responsible for the installation of soil erosion and sediment control devices, rip rap; related earth excavation; fill, borrow, landscaping, topsoil and seedbed material; and storing and stockpiling material and required stabilization measures.

The base bid includes all work necessary for the project. There is a Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting on Wednesday, December 2, 2009 at 2:00 PM EST in Room 303 of the RMB. Copies of the plans and specifications may be obtained from Room 301 of the RMB on Tuesday, November 24, 2009, for a refundable fee of one hundred and fifty dollars (\$150.00), provided conditions are met as outlined in the bid documents.

From Tuesday, November 24, 2009 until the date of opening the proposals, plans and specifications of the proposed project will be on file in Room 301 during normal business hours, and are available to prospective bidders. No proposal will be considered or accepted unless at the time of its filing the same shall be accompanied by a cash deposit, cashier's check, or certified check on a bank or trust company insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) and authorized to do business in NC in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the proposal. Alternatively, a five percent (5%) bid bond issued by a corporate surety licensed by the State of NC may be filed with the proposal. Bidders must be properly licensed under Chapter 87 of the NC General Statutes and must comply with nondiscrimination provisions. The City of Raleigh is an equal opportunity Municipality and invites small, minority and/or women business contractors to bid. The City Council reserves the right to reject any or all proposals.
