## UDO Advisory Group

The Unified Development Advisory Group is a group of citizens that have been selected by the City Council to provide feedback and information to the project consultants and City staff as the new development code project progresses. The members will meet at strategic times over the life of the project, conducting discussions and identifying issues related to the new development code, also known as a UDO (Unified Development Ordinance).

The selected members represent a variety of stakeholder groups and neighborhood groups across the city that have an interest in the development of the new regulations.

The Group will meet together for a minimum of seven (7) meetings through the project. All meetings are held at the Urban Design Center from 4-6 pm. Members of the public are invited to attend.
