Art- Portrait Painters Workshop: Learning the Human Head

Age: 16yrs and up. The skull is the foundation of all human expressions and likeness. In this workshop, we will explore basic proportions through studying the skull and feeling our own faces (the topographical information is always with us). We will then define the subtle surface planes as they transition over the bony structure while drawing from the model. We will begin with simple materials. Bring a sketch pad of rough newsprint, at least 12 inches x 18 inches, preferably up to 18 inches x 24 inches; vine charcoal, a kneaded eraser, and a drawing board large enough for your paper. If you have a few small clay modeling tools, bring them as well. We will have a few tools on hand, as well as handouts, and some air-drying non-toxic modeling clay to 'feel out' the forms if you wish to explore them in 3-D.
