



Raleigh Arts Commission 2016 Medal of Arts Call For Nominations

CRITERIA

- [1] Nominees must be current or former residents or have conducted their affairs in Wake County. Self nominations are permitted. Awards will not be given posthumously.
- [2] Nominations must describe lifetime extraordinary achievement in the arts by an individual or group and may be for:

INDIVIDUALS

- Visual, literary, multimedia or performing artists who have achieved extraordinary excellence in their art form.
- Visual, literary, multimedia or performing artists who have made an extraordinary contribution to their field and to the community at large.
- Individuals who have made an extraordinary contribution to the arts through volunteer service and/or financial support.

GROUPS

- Institutions, businesses, corporations or organizations that have made an extraordinary contribution to the arts through service and/or financial support.
- Non-profit arts organizations that have achieved extraordinary excellence in their art form or have made an extraordinary contribution to the arts.

GUIDELINES

AWARDS DECISIONS WILL BE BASED ON THE INFORMATION PRESENTED IN THE NOMINATION PACKET. IT IS IMPORTANT, THEREFORE, THAT THE INFORMATION BE COMPREHENSIVE AND COMPLETE.

The nomination packet must include each of the following items:

- Completed nomination form
- Narrative in support of the nomination, not to exceed 2 pages, typed
- Supporting materials such as newspaper clippings, etc. (copies on 8.5" by 11" sheets of paper, not originals), not to exceed 4 pages.
- Original letters of endorsement from two experts or professionals in the nominee's field. The endorser's position should be identified on the letterhead or in the body of the letter. If an endorser is related to or currently affiliated with the nominee, such relationship or affiliation must be disclosed in the endorser's letter. All letters of endorsement for a nominee must be from persons other than the nominator. Each letter of endorsement may not exceed 2 pages, typed.

Where nominations are in the category of service, both the quality of the art and the nature of the service must be adequately documented in the nomination packet.

Nominations close on Thursday, March 31, 2016 at 4 pm.

The Arts Commission's Raleigh Medal of Arts awards program is funded by the City of Raleigh, individuals, and business sponsors.

The Arts Office staff is available for guidance in preparing nominations.
