1. Welcome –Chair Robert Rice called the meeting to order at 7:02.
2. Police report –Barbie Upchurch gave another good report. Several burglaries occurred because doors or windows were unlocked.
3. Parks Report – Tory Miller reported that Laurel Hills has been very busy with 3000 people this month. The park will close for renovation on \_\_\_\_\_ and will be closed for 1½ year. Recently there was a celebration of groundbreaking for the Chavis Park renovation.
4. Housing and Neighborhoods – Luis Olivieri-Robert, Community Relations Analyst, reported that \$10,000 is available for grants for landscaping projects for community beautification. 5. Minutes – The minutes of the August meeting were approved as distributed.
6. Grubb Ventures proposed text change/zoning – Anne Stoddard and Isabel Mattox – 3800 Glenwood requests a text change to modify a single condition of Z-67-05, related to a conditional use rezoning approved in 2005. The change refers to allowed restaurant space in the building. It does not change the total amount of space involved but it would allow for fewer but larger spaces. The proposal was approved 7 - 0

The meeting was adjourned at 7:26.
