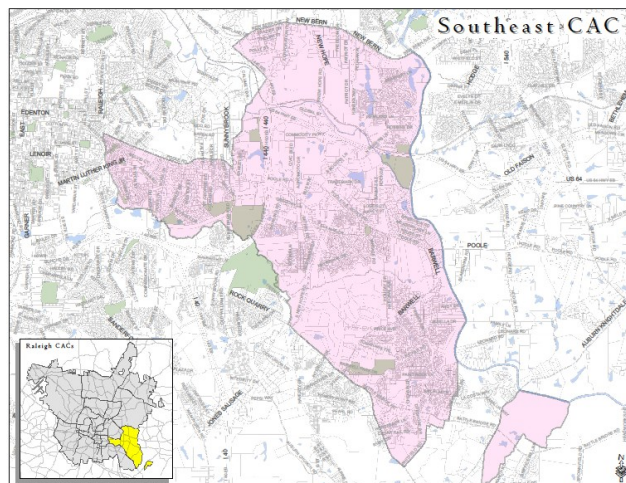

Southeast CAC: Minutes from the February, 8th 2018

The monthly meeting of the Southeast CAC was held at the Worthdale Community Center on Thursday, February 08, 2018. Presiding over the meeting was Co-Chair Lee Weaver who thanked residents and presenters for coming out. Other officers in attendance included 1st Vice Chair Latonia Williams, and Community Specialist Jonathan Edwards.

Raleigh Parks, Recreation & Cultural Resources Report was given by Worthdale Center Assistant Director, Troy Smith shared the following: (1) Weight room workout for February is free. City wide promotion at all centers; (2) Pee WEE basketball League ends February 17,2018; (3)Spring baseball/Softball registration start February 5-23,2018,ages 5-17 at \$40.00for Raleigh residence and \$55.00 for non-residence ; (4) Free Yoga class held on Thursdays 11:00 am-11:45(5)HIP Hop dance &Step classes held on Monday Thursday from 6:30 pm-7:30 pm for ages 7-14.Fee of \$25.00 for residence and 40.00 for non-residence.

Law Enforcement report was given by Officer Lee Raleigh Police Department. Copies of the SE CAC incident report were distributed, and Officer Lee shared (1) assaults (mostly domestic) were down during this period but commercial burglaries were up 20%; (2) residential burglaries were down some; (3) larceny from motor vehicles was down 53%. Officer Lee stated that many (9) larcenies were from unlocked vehicles. He continued to encourage residents to "*Lock, Take & Hide*" items that are visible to public. (4) motor vehicle theft was up 50 %.

A Special report was given by RPD Chief Cassandra Deck-Brown at South East CAC meeting introducing idea to relocate the RPD Southeast District station. The take-aways: officers will remain at the Southgate location; the new location is almost double the space; this is a conceptual design only, nothing etched in stone; this was the first of additional meeting
