Bidders must be duly licensed according to State of North Carolina General Statutes Chapter 87 and must comply with the City Non-Discrimination provisions.

Pursuant to General Statutes of North Carolina Section 143-128 and 143-131 and to City policy, the City of Raleigh encourages and provides equal opportunity for certified Minority and Woman-Owned Business Enterprise (MWBE) businesses to participate in all aspects of the City's contracting and procurement programs to include – Professional Services; Goods and other services and construction.

The prime contractor will be required to identify participation of MWBE businesses in their proposal, and how that participation will be achieved.

Furthermore, the City's goal is to contract or sub-contract fifteen percent (15%) of the contract amount to certified MWBEs on construction projects over \$300,000 or with contracts that include \$100,000 or more in state funding. The goal breakdown is 8% for minorities and 7% for non-minority females

There will be a mandatory pre-bid conference which will begin at 2:00 pm, Thursday, Oct 6, 2016 at the 2 E South St, Raleigh NC 27601.
