Separate sealed Bids will be received until **2:00 PM, Thursday, December 1, 2016**, at One Exchange Plaza, Suite 620, Raleigh, NC 27601, at which time and place, bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for the construction of the EM Johnson Water Treatment Plant West Reservoir Residuals Removal project.

After Bids are opened, the Owner shall evaluate them in accordance with the methods and criteria set forth in the Instructions to Bidders. The Owner/City Council reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all Bids. Unless all Bids are rejected, Award will be made to the lowest responsible Bidder, taking into consideration quality, performance and the time specified in the proposals for the performance of the Contract.

A Mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting will be held at 10:00 am, Thursday, November 17, 2016 at the E.M. Johnson WTP Training Facility, 10301 Falls of Neuse Road, Raleigh, NC 27614. A picture ID is required for entry into the water plant facility. Attendance by all bidders is mandatory. Proposals will not be accepted by the City of Raleigh from bidders that are not present at the Mandatory Pre-bid Meeting.

The Project consists of the following major items:

- Removal of Class A residual sludge from the West Terminal Reservoir at the EM Johnson Water Treatment Plant (WTP). **Dredging of sludge will not be allowed on this project.**
- Off-site Disposal of Class A residuals removed from the West Reservoir in accordance with the City of Raleigh's Class A residuals permit.
- Maintenance and any necessary improvements to haul roads on the EM Johnson WTP site necessary to complete the work.
- Rent, supply and installation of temporary truck scale at the EM Johnson WTP for the duration of the project.

Complete Bidding Documents may be obtained at the office of the Engineer upon providing a \$50 non-refundable fee for each set of documents, which includes all contracts.

With request for Bidding Documents supply the following information: Company name, contact person, street address, and phone and fax numbers for Bidding office; N. C. contractor's license with limitation and classification; indicate if the firm will be a Bidder, Supplier or Sub-Contractor.

Bid Security in the amount of five percent of the Bid must accompany each Bid and shall be subject to the conditions provided in the Instruction to Bidders.

The City of Raleigh prohibits discrimination in any manner on the basis of race, color, creed, national origin, sex, age, handicap or sexual orientation and will pursue an affirmative policy of fostering, promoting, and conducting business with women and minority owned business enterprises.

The City of Raleigh has adopted an overall goal of 15% for participation by minority or women-owned business (with subgoals of 8% for minority-owned and 7% for women-owned) for formal contracts awarded for construction by the City. The Bidder must include completed minority or women-owned subcontractor documentation form(s) regardless of bid amount or the bids may be considered non-responsive and invalid.

The Contractor has the option to visit the West Reservoir and perform their own reservoir dimension measurements, sludge depth measurements and sludge sampling before submitting a bid. The Contractor shall contact the following City staff member to coordinate a visit to the water treatment plant during the bidding phase:
