Separate sealed Bids will be received until 2:00 PM, Tuesday, December 20, 2016, at One Exchange Plaza, Suite 620, Conference Room 1, Raleigh, NC 27602, at which time and place bids will be publicly opened and read aloud for the construction of the East Street, Lenoir Street, Holden Street, and Corporation Parkway Priority Sewer and Water Rehabilitation and Replacement project.

After Bids are opened, the Owner shall evaluate them in accordance with the methods and criteria set forth in the Instructions to Bidders. The Owner/City Council reserves the right to waive any informality or to reject any or all Bids. Unless all Bids are rejected, Award will be made to the lowest responsible Bidder, taking into consideration quality, performance and the time specified in the proposals for the performance of the Contract.

A **Mandatory** Pre-Bid Meeting will be held at 3:30 PM, Wednesday, November 30, 2016 at One Exchange Plaza, Suite 620, Conference Room 1, Raleigh, NC 27602.

The Project consists of the following major items:

- Furnish and install approximately 2,430 LF 8-Inch DIP Sanitary Sewer
- Furnish and install approximately 1,970 LF 6-Inch DIP Water Main
- Furnish and install approximately 1,800 LF 8-Inch CIPP
- Associated pavement and surface restoration, erosion control, and other appurtenances

With request for Bidding Documents supply the following information: Company name, contact person, street address, and phone and fax numbers for Bidding office; N. C. contractor's license with limitation and classification; indicate if the firm will be a Bidder, Supplier or Sub-Contractor.

Bidders will be required to show evidence that they are licensed to perform the work in the Bidding Documents as required by North Carolina General Statute, Chapter 87 and the Instruction to Bidders.

Bid Security in the amount of five percent of the Bid must accompany each Bid and shall be subject to the conditions provided in the Instruction to Bidders.

The City of Raleigh prohibits discrimination in any manner on the basis of race, color, creed, national origin, sex, age, handicap or sexual orientation and will pursue an affirmative policy of fostering, promoting, and conducting business with women and minority owned business enterprises.

The City of Raleigh has adopted an overall goal of 15% for participation by minority or women-owned business (with subgoals of 8% for minority-owned and 7% for women-owned) for formal contracts awarded for construction by the City. The Bidder must include completed minority or women-owned subcontractor documentation form(s) regardless of bid amount or the bids may be considered non-responsive and invalid.
