Are you fascinated with wildlife, science, space and ocean life? Join us as we explore the newly opened Greensboro Science Center. We will be leaving from Anne Gordon Active Adult Center at Millbrook Exchange Park (1901 Spring Forest Road) at 8:00am.

The Greensboro Science Center is the only facility in the state that offers four attractions in one destination: science museum, zoological park, OmniSphere Theatre and aquarium. The hands-on science museum allows you to walk among ancient animals in the Dinosaur Gallery, explore the human body in Health-Quest, experience extreme weather, check out the reptiles in the Herpetarium and much more. The Animal Discovery Park offers up close encounters with many amazing animals including tigers, meerkats, monkeys, wallabies, wolves, a red panda. The Friendly Farm Petting Zoo and Discovery House allow you to pet live animals. Keeper Talks give you an opportunity to learn from the experts. The SciQuarium features live sharks, penguins, fishing cats, stingrays as well as exotic fish. You have the opportunity to experience the OmniSphere Theater, on your own. Enjoy a full dome or a 3-D awe-inspiring digital show in the 40 foot dome theater. Use this visit and your time to focus your attention on what interests you. Whenever you get hungry the center has a Fresh Market Café where you can enjoy lunch on your own.
