About The Project:

The City of Raleigh is improving Scotland Street. The improvements extend from Beaufort Street to Lassiter Mill Road/St. Marys Street.

The project includes installation of:

- Curb and gutter along the entire length of the project on both sides of the street;
- New sidewalk along the north side and on the south side from Lakeview Drive to Lassiter Mill Rd;
- Storm drains; and,
- New pavement on the street.

Award Construction Contract - Jan. 2020
Project Completion - Summer 2020
