Greetings Brentwood Today Lake Residents and Surrounding Community:

The City of Raleigh would like to provide you with an update on the proposed Brentwood Today Stream Stabilization project. While the City of Raleigh Stormwater Management Division was planning and preparing plans to reconstruct the dam and spillway of Brentwood Today Lake and stabilize the downstream channel, the dam breached. The Brentwood Today Lake property owner is currently planning to address the old lake bed. The City is moving forward with plans to stabilize the breached dam embankment and the downstream channel.

The City has selected HDR of the Carolinas to provide professional engineering services. The City and HDR have met to discuss the best approach to stabilize the channel. Your input is very important to the City and we would like to hear from you. Nearby property owners and members of the community are invited to an upcoming meeting. The meeting will be held at Green Road Park Community Center, 4201 Green Road Raleigh, NC on May 25, 2016 at 6:30 PM.
