Dear Laurel Hills Dam Resident;

The City of Raleigh Stormwater Management Division is hosting a public meeting to discuss the current status of the Laurel Hills Dam Project. The City implemented new policies regarding roadway improvements requiring Laurel Hills Road be widened, the installation of curb and gutter, narrow bicycle lanes, and sidewalks across the top of the dam. Stormwater staff met with the property owners directly impacted by the changes and determined the best approach is to realign the road. The realignment will reduce the impact to Hester Pond and will improve traffic flow over the dam. A public meeting was held on July 27, 2015 to discuss the improvements. The City received numerous comments and has taken them into consideration.

The City would like to invite you to the public meeting to discuss and receive comments about the project. The meeting will be held on **Thursday, March 31, 2016 at 6:30 PM at the Laurel Hills Community Center located at 3808 Edward Mills Road, Raleigh, NC 27612**.
