Dear Property Owner or Resident,

During 2014 the City of Raleigh Stormwater Management Division and our consultant, Hazen and Sawyer, have been studying the Laurel Hills area to identify solutions for local drainage concerns that may qualify for improvements that will benefit the overall public drainage system. At a neighborhood meeting on January 16, 2014, we described the scope of our study and how residents could provide information about drainage concerns. Shortly after, many of you responded to our survey and provided helpful information. We then followed up with visits to areas of concern and met with some residents to observe and better understand conditions and effects. More recently we have been evaluating causes and solutions for the reported concerns, and surveyors are collecting field measurements we will apply to more detailed analyses.

Neighborhood participation is important for comprehensive evaluation and identifying solutions that both alleviate drainage problems and are supported by the community. We have developed a range of solution approaches to present at a second neighborhood meeting on December 11, 2014, from 6:30 to 8:00 pm at Glen Eden Pilot Park. After presenting, we will be available to answer questions while attendees are gathered and with individuals afterward.

We look forward to continuing this work in Laurel Hills and similar projects throughout Raleigh.
