Dear Property Owner or Resident,

The City of Raleigh Stormwater Management Division and our consultant, Hazen and Sawyer, have evaluated drainage concerns in the Laurel Hills area and have identified solution approaches for addressing them and benefitting the public stormwater management system as a whole. At neighborhood meetings on January 16 and December 11, 2014, we described the scope of this study, how residents could provide information about drainage concerns, and a range of conceptual solution approaches.

Based on neighborhood feedback and City stormwater management policies, we have evaluated solution approaches in more detail and have selected approaches we recommend move forward to the City's process for prioritizing stormwater management needs citywide. Because community acceptance is an important part of making our final selections, we are holding a third neighborhood meeting to get community input on the proposed approaches.

On July 13, 2015 at 7:00 at Laurel Hills Community Center, we will provide an overview of this study, identified concerns, and proposed solution approaches. Immediately afterward and until 8:30, City and consultant staff will be available to meet with property owners individually or in small groups to discuss specific solutions and how they relate to specific properties. Please review the enclosed map and consider attending this meeting, particularly if your property has been affected by a drainage concern or may be affected by a solution we are considering.

We look forward to continuing this work in Laurel Hills and similar projects throughout Raleigh.
