Re: Laurel Hills Area Stormwater Management Study
Access to Property for Land Surveying

Dear Property Owner,

You might recall from previous mailings and a neighborhood meeting on January 16, 2014 that the City of Raleigh and our consultant, Hazen and Sawyer, is studying the Laurel Hills area to identify solutions for qualifying local drainage problems that are candidates for improvements to benefit the overall public drainage system. We have compiled information you and your neighbors provided, and Hazen and Sawyer is evaluating potential solutions. Late this fall, we will host a second neighborhood meeting for presenting potential solutions and receiving residents' comments and input. We then will prioritize and budget potential solutions relative to City-wide needs for drainage improvements.

From September through November, surveyors will be working in your neighborhood mapping drainage structures, utilities, buildings, and other features so that existing conditions are considered in our evaluations. Surveying will begin in September along streets and, after 30 days from the date of this letter, surveying may extend onto private properties as needed for our evaluations. Surveyors will wear orange vests and will carry a letter from the City that authorizes and describes their work. They will be instructed to minimize their time on private properties and to cooperate with property owners and tenants. If you have reason to think surveyors might have difficulty accessing your property (such a locked gate or an unrestrained pet), please let me know so we can make special arrangements.

We look forward to continuing this work in Laurel Hills and similar projects throughout Raleigh.
